# GLOBAL, EUROPEAN AND FINNISH SECURITY LANDSCAPE



## **Surveillance tools and governments**

- USA utilize unlawful and questionable actions in cyberspace
- UK gets hit by it's own actions (i.e. BA meltdown)
- DE start decrypting and “hacking back” in large scale
- FI is preparing laws for full scale surveillance rights

## **European Union regulatory actions**

- General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), Network Information Systems (NIS)

## **ENISA recommendations and publications**

- Airport security, SmartGrid security
- SmartCars and IoT
- Various programs to secure 5G



## **Global overheating**

- Global demand for employment → very good incomes possible
- Engineers, programming, sales, consultants ...
- WannaCry taught us that old, unpatched software is a severe risk
- Human factor remains the biggest threat and nothing seems to challenge it

## **European Companies in CyberSec**

- Only handful of high level EU based companies left
- In Finland we are only a few anymore
- Government's starting to think maybe this require in-house development by gov's

# PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT PROJECT - SSHFW



## SSH Firewall

- Firewall with IPsec VPN
- **Finnish source code** from scratch
  - IP stack (dualstack IPv4 and IPv6)
  - Engine for packet forwarding, filtering, IKEv2 and tunneling
  - Policy Manager for multi-policy environment
  - Graphical User Interface and standard-API (rest-API)
- Based on standard Intel CPU and commonly available hardware
- Able to saturate multiple 10G Ethernet links
  - Currently 16x 10G in one 2U server, >50 Mpps, >1M/s flow setup rate
  - AES-GCM\_256 encryption, SHA-2 and TLS 1.2
