TREX is pleased to host a workshop on multi-exit BGP together with sponsors **Juniper Networks**¹ and **Cisco Systems**². The workshop will be of value to anyone interested in arranging multiple peering or transit locations in their network, and anyone interested in peering at **TREX Tampere Region Exchange**³.

Multi-exit BGP refers to the case where two operators have multiple interconnections in different places, such as on internet exchanges in different cities. Adopting this practise often warrants a rethinking of traffic engineering and peering policies.

The workshop will be held on Thursday, February 12th 2009 at the **Hermia Auditorium**⁴ in Tampere from 12:00 to 17:00.
